

Audition Requirements for Virtual NYB 2021

Both section 1 & 2 are required.

1. Scales:

- Full Chromatic on instrument
- Concert F and Ab Major: Full range of instrument ending with arpeggios, full range of instrument.

2. Musical Excerpts: Special thank you to University of Saskatchewan for allowing the CBA to use their audition material. There are two excerpts (shown between the brackets):

1-Irish Tune from County Derry (Grainger)

2–Symphony in Bb (Hindemith)

3. Submit your recording:

- The audition form is on the Canadian Band Association <u>NYB Website</u>.
- Make your recording the highest quality possible. Only mp3 files are accepted.
- Auditions are judged anonymously. Do not digitally alter or splice a recording during a scale, arpeggio, or excerpts. Talking on the recording or use of a metronome may result in disqualification.
- Upload your recording online as a single file (ie. one track). Directions on how to combine audio files for submission can be located <u>HERE!</u>
- Auditions received after the deadline will be considered in the event of a recall.
